AT A GLANCE:

- Highly skilled people to migrate to the UK to look for work
- Employed or self-employed work
- Points based system
- You do not need an employer to apply
- You will be allowed to come to the UK for up to one year to find work
- After a year, you can apply to stay longer, must be economically active
- Can lead to settlement
- You can apply to bring your dependants

GENERAL

The innovative programme is designed to attract talented, highly skilled people to the UK to look for work or self-employment opportunities. Self-employed General Practitioners and Dentists qualified to practice in the UK may apply under the Highly Skilled Migrant Programme.

PLAN OF ACTION

You can apply from abroad or, in some cases, from inside the UK if you are here with Home Office permission. You cannot apply if you are in the UK as a visitor, on temporary admission, or without permission, but could of course return home to apply. (see *Chapter 8* of “How 2 Come to the UK” for a list of useful websites and contact details).
